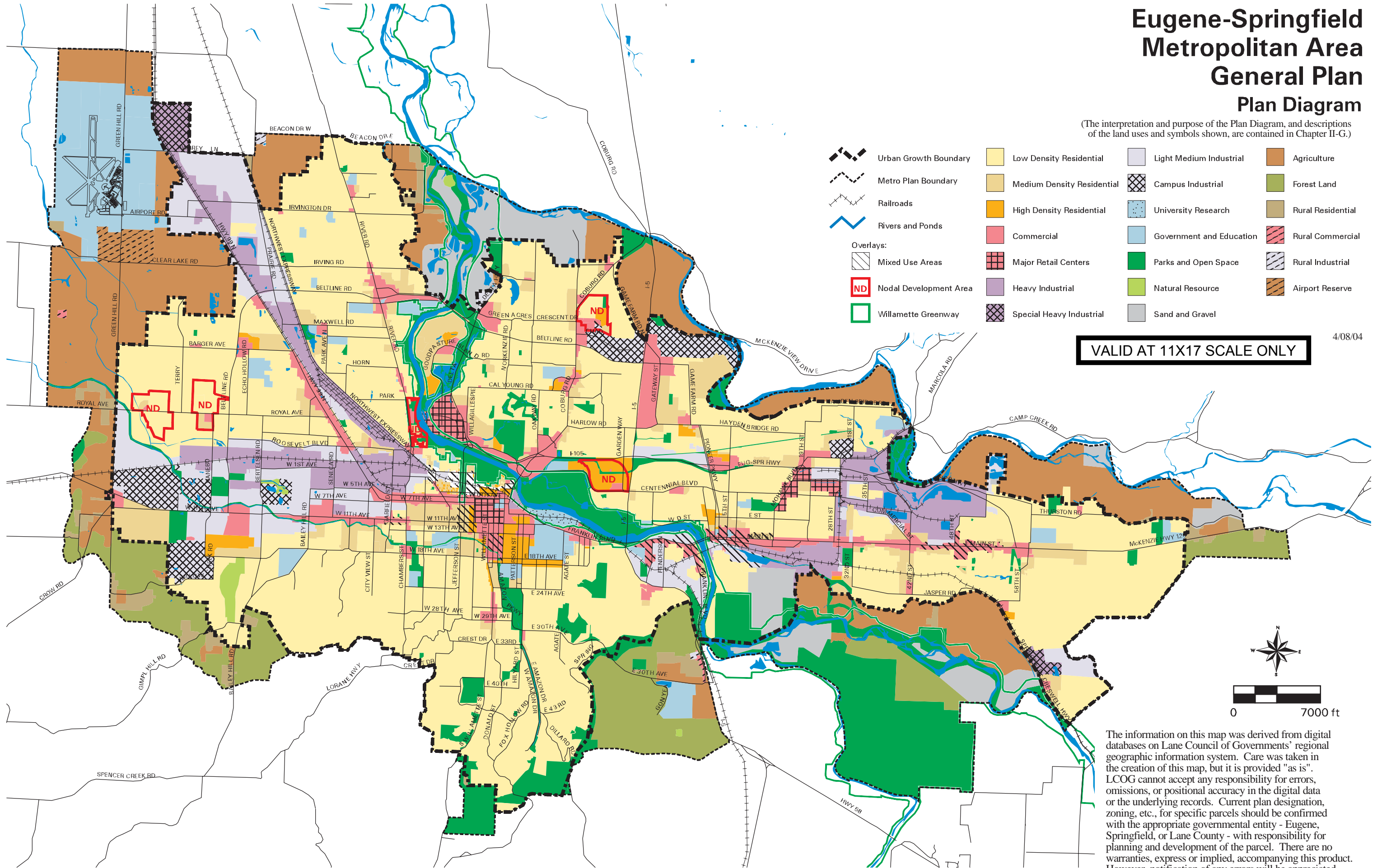


Eugene-Springfield Metropolitan Area General Plan Plan Diagram

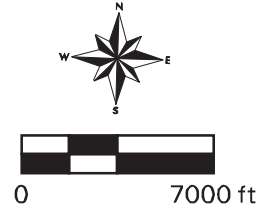
